

Confined Space Awareness



Program Overview:

- This program is based on Confined Space Regulation 629/05 and the CSA Z1006-16 Standard. The program teaches overall confined space awareness, existing and potential confined space hazards, methods to control and eliminate hazards, training requirements, attendant and entrant as well as workplace responsibilities, the permit, entry planning, authorization and emergency and rescue procedures.

- Confined Space Entry Plan
- Testing & Monitoring
- Entry Permits
- Attendant and Entrant
- Communication

- Rescue Requirements

Course Duration:

- Eight (8) Hours dependent upon number of participants

NOTE: Confined Space Rescue Training is an additional ½-day of training, based on practical applications and scenarios using the participants workplace rescue equipment.
